Hansen's Dairy is a family-owned dairy farm. Seven generations have managed and lived on the farm and it is a designated Iowa Heritage Farm. One of the very special features of Hansen's Dairy is the kangaroos. Yes. Kangaroos! They've been such a mainstay of the farm that a kangaroo became part of their logo.



The tour will guide you through the process of getting milk from the cow to the table. It starts with a trolley ride to the farm, then a walking tour to see their cows, calves, kangaroos, milking parlor, barn and creamery. Everyone gets ice cream.

- **Victorian Home & Carriage House Museum**

The oldest of Cedar Falls' museums, this 1862 Italianate-style home features antique furnishings, fashions, and memorabilia from the 1880-1900's. The Carriage House addition houses the famous O-scale Lenoir Model Train Exhibit.
